The meeting was called to order by Lee at 1:30 P.M. With no public comment on the agenda, a motion was requested to approve the 01/29/26 meeting minutes. Amber made the motion, and it was seconded by Lisa. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Lee shared that the MAWIB Board approved the recommended \$175,000.00 Youth Services Provider Contract with SWIC.

Lee shared that performance measures are at “Meets or Exceeds” in all categories.

Brenda shared performance metrics, enrollment numbers, and training outcomes. Brenda presented updates on PY25 contract enrollment, reporting 33 total new youth enrolled (8 in-school and 25 out-of-school) and 32 for the SWIC portion, bringing the total to 57 new participants. She also shared program exit data, noting that 32 people left the program, with 12 completing high school or GED, 10 entering unsubsidized employment, and 7 earning degrees or certificates.

Brenda discussed some upcoming events, such as the Career Expo at Grizzley’s Ball Park April 8th, a Day in the Trades event on April 20th at Redbud High School, and a CTE career fair at East St. Louis Senior High School on April 28th, all aimed at promoting training and employment opportunities to youth.

Having no other business, the meeting adjourned at 1:51 pm.
